FHI 360 and RISE Life Management Services (RISE) invite Jamaican grassroots and community-based organizations (CBOs) that address youth crime and violence in volatile or vulnerable communities in Kingston or St. Andrew to submit Expressions of Interest (EOIs) for possible inclusion in the Local Partner Development (LPD), Stepping Stone to Success Program. The Stepping Stone to Success Program for CBOs in Kingston and St. Andrew will be delivered by RISE and will provide selected CBOs with tailored support, coaching, and practical skills-based training on how to improve their community work and interventions related to youth crime and violence.

This Request for Expressions of Interest (REOI) applies to small community-based entities regardless of their registration status.
